Welcome to the 2018-19 school year at West High School - International Baccalaureate World School. Summer is coming to a close and the school year is just weeks away. We are excited to welcome all our returning and new students to West High School with some great news. In late spring, West was authorized by the International Baccalaureate program to offer the Middle Years Program for our 9th and 10th grade students. We are now officially an IB school from 9th to 12th grade. (For more information, we will be hosting a question and answer session about IB for curious parents and community members this fall with a date TBA.) Green Bay Area Public School District is now the only district in Northeast Wisconsin to offer the continuum of IB programs.

Sadly, we said good-bye to some staff at the end of the 2017-18 school year but we have hired new staff who are excited and committed to great work here at West. New this year, West has qualified for CEP which is a federal program that grants schools the opportunity to offer breakfast and lunch at no cost to all students that attend. For the 2018-19 school year we will offer breakfast, lunch and dinner for all students who attend at no cost.

# BACK TO SCHOOL REGISTRATION SCHEDULE

Enter through the Main Office doors (Door #1), west side of building.

Wednesday, August 22nd

2 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Thursday, August 30th

7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**Parents and students** are expected to attend one registration session prior to the first student day on **September 4**. Participating in this process will prepare your child and your family for the first day of school. Allow approximately one hour to complete the registration process.

## SAVE TIME AT REGISTRATION

- **Every family must review**, update and maintain your student's demographic information with the district. This school year parents/guardians have the ability to update your student's demographic information online through Infinite Campus's Parent Portal. The portal is now open, and parents/guardians are asked to complete this online process prior to attending a registration session. **THIS WILL SAVE YOU CONSIDERABLE TIME AT REGISTRATION!** If you do not complete the updates prior to attending Registration, you will be required to make updates on a computer at registration or at the District's Central Registration at the District Office Building at 200 S. Broadway. Please contact the Help Desk at 448-2148 with any Parent Portal questions.

### Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner at No Cost

We are excited to announce that West High School is participating in the Community Eligibility Provision Program (CEP) for the 2018-2019 school year. This means that all students will be provided breakfast, lunch and dinner at no cost. More information will be forthcoming.

### At registration your family will accomplish the following:

- ◆ Parents will review/update contact information (*if not done prior*) and complete any other school forms requiring parent signatures.
- ◆ Students will receive class textbooks, Chromebooks (*in LMC*), schedules, and locker information.
- ◆ Students will take school pictures (Ambrosius Studio) and receive student ID card. **Please come dressed appropriately for school portraits.** *Order envelopes will be provided at the time pictures are taken.*
- ◆ Apply for student parking passes.
- ◆ Pay for school fees, activity passes, locks, goggles, parking permits, student planners, etc.
- ◆ Activate Food Service accounts and complete or check status of food service applications.

Bring proof of address ***if you have moved.***  
Acceptable documents are lease, mortgage or most recent utility bill.

# 2018-19 West High School Supply List

## ART:

- All Classes: Pencil, Eraser, and Folder.
- Drawing & Painting 1 will need a Sharpie.
- *Additional supplies or fees may be required and can be purchased from art teacher.*

## BUSINESS:

- Pencils and Notebooks (USB flash drive optional but helpful)

## FAMILY & CONSUMER SCIENCE:

- Notebook, folder, pens/pencils

## LANGUAGE ARTS:

- Pencils, pens, highlighter, post-it notes/flags, notebook or 3-ring binder
- *\*The use of notebooks or 3-ring binders varies by teacher and students will be informed which is preferred during the first week of class.*

## MATH:

- Any level of Algebra 1 or Algebra 2: Graph paper, notebook or loose leaf paper, scientific calculator
- Geometry, Advanced Geometry, Introduction to Statistics: Graph paper, notebook or loose leaf paper, scientific calculator, compass, straight edge and protractor
- Pre-Calculus: Graph paper, notebook or loose leaf paper, scientific calculator (optional: graphing calculator)
- TI-30XS multi-view calculator

## PHYSICAL EDUCATION:

1. *An appropriate change of clothes for daily activities. T-shirt, shorts, and socks.*
  2. *Tennis shoes*
  3. *Cold weather clothing, sweatshirt and wind pants*
  4. *Optional – Heart monitor strap, purchase from PE teacher \$20*
- \*\*An activity fee can be expected for units such as bowling, swimming, and golf. This fee will cover the cost of participation and transportation.*

## SCIENCE:

- Safety Goggles (may be purchased at school), Scientific Calculator, notebook or loose leaf paper, folder, pens, pencils, and 3-ring binder

## SOCIAL STUDIES:

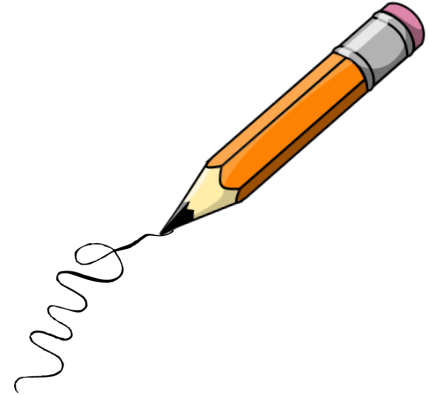
- All Classes: Loose-leaf paper or notebook, pens and pencils

**Attention all students**

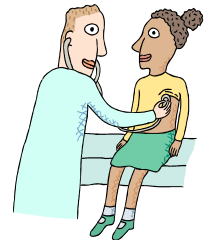
